All girls are Bangladeshi. They have completed their rehabilitation process with us.

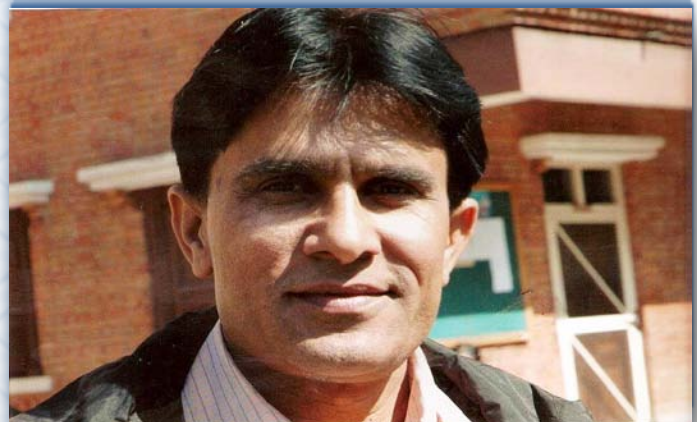
